the river as previously announced. It will cover just over two hundred miles in two days with a campout in between.

F.A.I.R. DESERT ADVENTURE

WHAT IS IT?

A three day two night adventure in the Mojave Desert.

Starting Friday afternoon participants will arrive at the Slash X Cafe in Barstow to check in. The Slash X offers good grub and the usual Slash X good time for those who wish to take part. Then the party will move to the free camping area behind the Slash X where most will be camping Friday night.

Saturday Morning after breakfast, the group will depart for a two day, and more than two hundred mile round trip including parts of the Mojave Rd. and the East Mojave Heritage Trail. Saturday night will include a specially prepared meal and campout near some of California's geological wonders.

After breakfast Sunday morning the group will travel over some of the most amazing ground traversed by early California Pioneers before returning Sunday afternoon to the Slash X and comparing notes prior to heading back to civilization.

Does it cost money?

Participants will buy a book of script for \$10.00 which will be traded for meals along the trail, and buy cards for the Poker run.

What about other meals?

Meals at the Slash X are optional, and everyone should pack trail snacks for the trip.

Who Can Go?

All F.A.I.R. members, family and guests are encouraged to go.

Non members must be sponsored by a club member who will be responsible for communicating information and assuring that people and vehicle are prepared for the trip.

What kind of Vehicle?

Any offroad worthy vehicle including prunners, race cars, 4X4's Two wheel drive pick up trucks. We also need chase vehicles to follow along the highways and graded roads. No Motorcycles or Quads.

My whole family won't fit in my vehicle.

No problem, a second vehicle could follow on the highway and meet in areas where drivers and passengers could trade off.

What do I bring?

Sleeping Bags, tent, cot or mattress, clothing, Drinking water or other fluids. Flashlight or lantern, personal and sanitary items. Folding chairs and lounges, trail and camp snacks. If you wish to bathe, bring water, towel, soap. If your vehicle has less than 140 mile range on pump gas, bring extra fuel. A shovel, jack, tow rope, and first aid should be carried on the vehicle.

I Can't carry all that.

A box van will be provided to haul your stuff. Please limit what you bring as space will be limited.

When is it?

We will arrive Friday October 11th, or early morning Saturday the 12th. Sunday, October 13th, we will be back to Slash X where you are welcome to stay the night or head for home.

Can I Chase?

We need people to chase. Chase vehicles will be needed to pull a flat bed trailer in case of breakdown, haul the equipment and gear, run to town for ice etc.

What about, you know?

There won't be any public restrooms except for the possibility of a rest stop Saturday morning.

There will be ample places to take care of business, and plenty of opportunities.

Bring your own paper products.

Where will I leave my trailer and tow vehicle?

Vehicles may be left in the camping area behind the Slash X. We will designate an area where our vehicles will be, and the Slash X people will periodically check on them.

What about weather?

Be prepared. Only heavy rainfall will cancel our trip.

Where do I sign up?

Is there a deadline?

The deadline for joining our group is September 28, at that time we must know who is going, in what vehicle (type) and their fees must be paid.

What if I breakdown?

If your repair cannot be taken care of in a short amount of time, one of the group will tow you to a point where a chase vehicle will assist you.

What are the rules of the road?

Our schedule will be based on an average speed of 20 miles per hour. All vehicles will be expected to keep a safe distance between each other, and not to pass while on the designated route. Depending on how many vehicles and what type of vehicles we may split up into groups. Each group will be responsible to stay together. If the vehicle behind you stops, you stop. There will be radios in each group and on the chase vehicles. Weather, some parts of the route may be impassible for street type vehicles in which case they will be detoured, and rejoin elsewhere.
